30th March – New intake meeting with parents

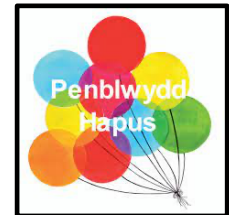
31st March – New intake to join Little Acorns for the morning.
