27th February – 3rd March – Welsh Week

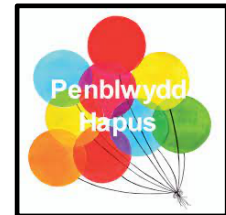

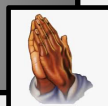
