Wednesday 19th June – First date for Sports Day

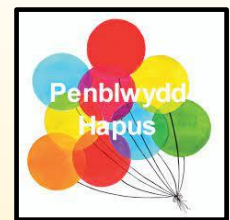

A reminder that Confirmation classes will be starting in May. Anyone wishing to be confirmed please see Mrs Rees or Mr Scale.

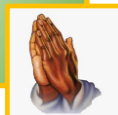
St Oswald's Has Got Talent
