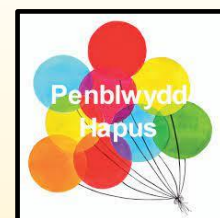

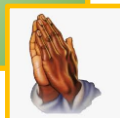
On Friday 17th May, members of Y Llais will be selling the remaining toys after school for a small donation.
