

## Literacy, Language and Communication

Our class novel will be 'The Boy in the Striped Pajamas'.

We will be focusing on fiction writing and describing a setting within pupils narrative writing.

After half term, we will be studying poetry.

Interventions will be taking place through handwriting and reading throughout the week.

**Cymraeg:** We will be using the new Continuum Cymraeg to structure our lessons this term. Pupils will take part in two half hour sessions a week where they will use their oracy skills to practise the sentence patterns in order to build up to an extended piece of writing. Pupils will also have a phrase of the week to practise in school and at home.

## Expressive Art

We will use drama to look at how people express their opinions in different ways to be heard. We will also use film and digital media to create our own war music.

Our focus this term will be Music and Sound. We will look at how sound is created, and how pitches and vibrations differ.

Pupils will have the opportunity to design their own war song using poems from their literacy work. Pupils will work with technology such as Garageband and Adobe Spark Video.
