7th December – Little Acorns and Willow Christmas play performance - afternoon and evening.

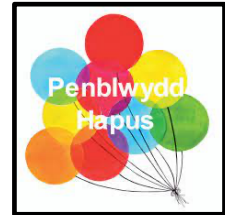
8th December – Elm and Sycamore Christmas play performance – afternoon and evening.

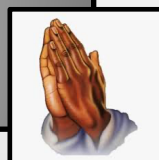
Prayer of the Month
