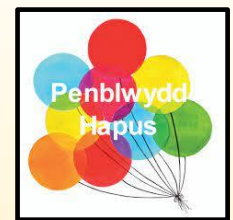

Currently, our school is rallying behind the cause with a Dogs4Wildlife collection jar, inviting contributions of any spare change that families may have at home.

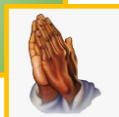
