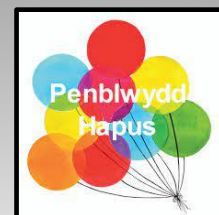

We will be selling toast for 50p a slice in the morning, and we will have a cake sale after school.

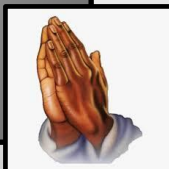
We would be very grateful for any donations of bread or cakes in the week leading up to this event.
